Description

CIKOkey Bond is a ready to use polyvinyl acetate emulsion based adhesive. It dries to a colourless transparent film.

CIKOkey Bond is an aqueous emulsion of PVA blended with modifiers to attain and enhance bonding and sealing properties suitable for different type of substrates such as, gypsum, plaster, renders, wood, stone, tiles, carpets, sheets etc.

Application instructions

Surface preparation

Clean the surface to make it free from dust, oil, loosely adhered particles, paint stains, efflorescence and other contaminations. The surface should be abraded or sand papered if applicable to provide a rough surface to receive the bonding agent.

Mixing

CIKOkey Bond is a ready to use adhesive that requires slight mixing and stirring prior to use.

Application method

Apply CIKOkey Bond using a brush without leaving any gap on both surfaces to be bonded at a rate ranging between 0.16 kg/m² up to 0.25 kg/m². Keep the applied adhesive for 10 up to 20 minutes (depending on prevailing ambient conditions) until it becomes hand touch tacky. Press firmly both items and support mechanically for at least 24 hours.

Curing

Allow the bonded areas supported mechanically for at least 24 hours. No specific curing is required. Protect the adhesive from any type of water flow.

Packaging

CIKOkey Bond is available in 5kg, 20 kg pails and 200 kg drums.

Shelf life

CIKOkey Bond has a shelf life of 12 months in unopened pack and if stored in accordance with manufacturer instructions.



Storage

CIKOkey Bond should be stored under enclosed shaded area at temperatures between $5^{\circ}C - 30^{\circ}C$.

Precautions

CIKOkey Bond should not be used in temperatures below 5° C

Health & Safety

CIKOkey Bond should not come in contact with eyes or be swallowed. Ensure adequate ventilation and avoid inhalation of vapours. Applicator should wear appropriate clothes, gloves and goggles. Use of barrier cream is recommended to provide additional skin protection. If comes in contact with eyes, flush with plenty of fresh water and seek medical advice.
